



DIPLOMA AND CERTIFICATE COURSES: APPLICATION GUIDELINES for Psychodrama Training

Eligibility for Certificate and Advanced Postgraduate Diploma in Psychodrama Psychotherapy

Applicants will demonstrate:

- A lively and enquiring mind.
- A capacity for critical reflection and self-directed learning.
- An ability to listen and respond with compassion and respect.
- Awareness of prejudice and the ability to respond openly to issues of race, gender, age, sexual preference, class, disability, ethnic, spiritual / religious and cultural difference, and diversity.
- Awareness and sensitivity in relation to the political, socio-cultural and religious / spiritual contexts of people's lives.
- In-depth self-reflection.
- Self-awareness and commitment to self-development.
- Applicants should have sufficient emotional competence and the internal resources necessary to engage with the demands of the training and the work of psychodrama / sociodrama.
- Evidence of a good command of written and spoken English (disability and equalities exceptions/ adaptations to requirement will always apply).
- Have relevant experience of working with people in a responsible role
- Should be in a position to meet the practical, emotional and intellectual requirements of the course.
- Applicants will not be discriminated against on grounds of race, gender, age, sexual preference, class, disability or ethnic, religious or cultural difference.
- Applicants should be in a position to meet the practical, emotional and intellectual requirements of the course.
- If you are successful in the application process you will also need to provide evidence of a current DBS check prior to being able to register with us as a trainee. You can use this link:

6. Number and ages of children
7. Schools attended since 11, with dates.
8. University and further education establishments attended, with dates.
9. University degrees and other qualifications and the dates these were gained.
10. Details of occupations since completing school.
11. Current health, medical and psychological.
12. Details of all previous treatment, medical and psychological.
13. Name, addresses and email details of two referees – one professional and one personal.
14. Reasons for application at this time.
15. Interests and activities other than work.
16. Current personal situation – what life is presenting you with at the moment, both in terms of work and in terms of family and social life.
17. Give an account of the key/ significant experiences of your life and how you feel about them.
